3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Most important hazards: Harmful if swallowed.

Specific hazards: May cause sensitisation by skin contact.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. Consult a physician.

Skin contact: Wash off immediately with soap and plenty of water.

Eye contact: Rinse thoroughly with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and consult a physician.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Drink plenty of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Consult a physician.
